Comprehensive Assessment

Conduct a **comprehensive assessment** of the circumstances of the Indian child's family, with a focus on **safe reunification** as the most desirable goal



Diligent Search

Conduct a **diligent search** for the Indian child's extended family members, and **contact and consult with extended family** members to provide family **structure and support** for the Indian child and the Indian child's parents



Identify, Notify, & Invite

Identify, notify, and invite
representatives of the Indian child's
Tribe to participate in providing
support and services to the Indian
child's family and in child and family
team meetings (permanency planning),
and resolution of placement issues

FAMILIES





Identify appropriate services and help the parents to overcome barriers, including actively assisting the parents in obtaining such services



Culturally Appropriate Services

Offer and employ all available and **culturally appropriate family preservation strategies** and facilitate the use of remedial and rehabilitative services provided by the child's Tribe



Support regular visits with parents or Indian custodians in the most natural setting possible as well as trial home visits of the Indian child during any period of removal, consistent with the need to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the child



Montior

Monitor **progress and participation** in services



Alternative Services

Consider **alternative** ways to address the needs of the Indian child's parents and, where appropriate, the family, if the optimum services do not exist or are not available



Siblings

Take steps to keep siblings together whenever possible



Community Resources

Identify community resources (housing, financial, transportation, ental health, substance abuse, and peer support) and actively assist the Indian child's parents or, when appropriate, the child's family, in utilizing and accessing those resources



Post Reunification

Provide **post-reunification** services and monitoring

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
